Target Group: Not age range or gender specific

Current Study: 2 Corinthians

Description: The church in Corinth was divided. Some followed the gospel, others believed the teachings of false apostles. Paul wrote a second letter to the Corinthians to defend the gospel of Christ by forcefully reminding his readers that what he taught was god's truth. In doing this, Paul provides an example to Christians today who must defend their own leadership in times of trouble.

Class Emphasis: This class focuses on studying the books of the Bible one book at a time. It moves at its own pace and is not tied to the standard quarterly study guide schedule. Drop-ins are welcome.

Mission Project(s): We try to do at least 2 mission projects per year. Our first mission of 2007 is to serve the Florida Baptist Children’s Home. We are scheduling an event for Valentine’s Day.

Target Group: Current age group is 50-65 years old, comprised primarily of couples. All age groups are welcome as well as singles.

Current Study: Ezra, Nehemiah & Esther

Description: Cyrus, King of Persia, issued a decree that the Jews in exile could return to their homeland, rebuild their Temple and city. Upon their return they are faced with the problems of reconstructing the destroyed Temple, establishing their communities and dealing with the various people groups who do not want them to succeed. With the help of strong spiritual leaders the people claim the promises made by God through Isaiah and Jeremiah. The Temple is rebuilt and the people experience revival. Through this study we see that God has a work for us and He has given us His promise to provide what we need to accomplish that work if we step out in faith as the exiles did and claim those promises.

Class Emphasis: Our study is focused on the books of the Bible, one book at a time. The schedule of study is quarterly and study guides are provided.

Mission Project(s): Our class is involved in providing Christmas gifts for two children at the Florida Baptist Children's Home and various other needs through the Children's Home. We have also support a mission project in Haiti. As needs arise our class has been very active in meeting those needs.

Social(s): Throughout the year our class will have about three or four fellowships. This year we had a Dinner Party in April, a Fish Fry in October and a Dessert Fellowship in December.

Current Study: Philippians

Description: Paul's letter to the Philippian Church was one filled with joy, even though he was writing from prison awaiting trial. He tells the Philippians how to have real joy, even in the hard circumstances of life.
